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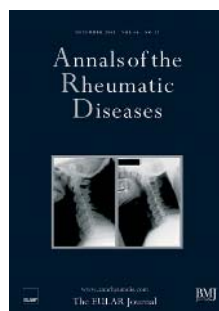
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Cervical spines of two family members with diffuse idiopathic skeletal hyperostosis. See p. 1794

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
